<b>Electronic time-stamp types and usage</b>	A description of each class/type of electronic time-stamps issued by the TSA (in accordance with each time-stamp policy) and any restrictions on time-stamp usage.	<p>The policy BTSP (see the ETSI EN 319 421 standard) and the one reported in the TSA Certificate Practice Statement (ICERT-INDI-TSA available on the InfoCert web site) apply.</p> <p>The algorithm for computing the digests is SHA256.</p> <p>Timestamps shall be requested and verified by using Dike 6, freely available on the InfoCert web site and shall be used following the rules laid down in the CPS, following a proper authentication.</p> <p>Timestamps validity is the same of the associated timestamp unit certificate.</p> <p>Timestamps shall be <b>only</b> used as prescribed by the CPS and Terms and Conditions. Any different usage is forbidden. Specifically, they may not be used for infringing rights or for violations of any kind of laws or regulations.</p>

Timestamps are made available following the payment of a fee. The provision of an Internet connection and of all the needed tools (hardware and software) is in charge to Subscribers.</p> <p>Subscribers shall inform possible users of timestamps about the applicable rules.</p> <p>Subscribers shall protect the secrecy of credentials necessary to access the Timestamp issuance system by not communicating or disclosing them to third parties.</p>

InfoCert shall be liable for its own fault or negligence. A predictable damage only may be refundable. The refunded amount in such cases may not exceed the cost of the acquired Timestamp.

All disputes arising out of or in connection with the interpretation and the execution of this Agreement, shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent courts of Rome, Italy. In the event that the Client is a consumer within the meaning of Article 66bis of the Italian Consumers' Code, any disputes related to the Agreement concluded by the consumer shall be referred to the mandatory territorial jurisdiction of the courts of their place of residence or domicile.
